THE ANNUAL DINNER IS OPEN TO FINANCIAL MEMBERS ONLY. The cost of the dinner remains at \$95 and includes pre-dinner drinks, canapés and a 3 course meal. Beer, wine and juice/soft drink may be purchased from the bar once the drinks package runs out. It might be easier to purchase wine before you enter the hall for dinner. The pay bar will operate until approximately 10.30pm.

Please use the electronic payment option if possible. **If you pay online you will still have to post in or email the completed Dinner Application form.** In the **identity box for online payments** please put your **name and last year at school** so that we can identify it as **your** payment.

We have to confirm numbers prior to the dinner and pay for that number. If you just turn up on the night, there is no guarantee of a dinner. Also, if you indicate by phone that you are attending and then do not turn up on the night, we still have to pay for your meal.

Next year may well be different but we will endeavour to keep to the price down.
