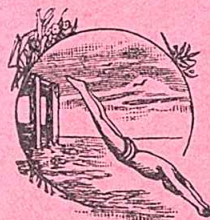

## SWIMMING CARNIVAL RULES.

1. Competitors must report to Marshals as soon as their events are called.
2. Competitors must leave the water immediately their events are finished.
3. Competitors must wear regulation costume with distinguishing caps.
4. Every competitor must touch the board on the completion of each lap, and at the finish of each race, with the hand ABOVE the water.
5. Place getters shall report to the Result Steward immediately they leave the water.
6. In the breast stroke event, when turning or finishing, the touch must be made with two hands simultaneously above the water.
7. Method of starting—Ready—Go (by word or mouth) or Ready—Pistol.
8. If the toe leave the starting board before the signal, a whistle shall be blown for a false start. Repetition of the offence will entail disqualification of the offender.
9. Diving, from the three metre board, shall include "Running Header," "Standing Header," and two fancy dives.
10. Failure to comply with these rules, or to obey the orders of officials, will result in disqualification.
11. Substitutes, with the committee's consent will be permitted in Relay Races only.
12. Races when possible will be swum in lanes.
13. The Champion in each Division will be the competitor who gains the highest number of points in his division. The Champion House will be the House that gains the highest aggregate points in all divisions.
14. Should the Entry for an event necessitate heats, such shall be arranged.
