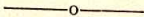

RULES

1. (a) An Announcement will be made two minutes before each event; (b) all competitors in any event must be at the scratch mark before the first heat is run.

2. None but officials and competitors are allowed on the course. **All competitors must leave the course immediately on the conclusion of their event.**

3. The Referee shall decide all questions relating to the conduct of the meeting not otherwise settled by these Rules.

4. (a) Protests to be dealt with by the Committee; (b) No protest will be entertained unless lodged with one of the Judges within fifteen minutes of the conclusion of the event.

5. The Committee reserves the right to alter any handicap.

6. All competitors must appear in the correct running costume.

7. In a Hurdle Race, any competitor knocking down three or more hurdles shall be disqualified.

8. Spiked shoes must not be worn in any Novelty Event.

9. Changes in relay teams may be made only by consent of the committee.

10. All competitors must have been in attendance at the school one month prior to the date of the meeting.

11. In the cup sections, competitors must be under the specified age on 20th August.

12. The senior and junior cups will be awarded on points gained in six of the championship events nominated previously by the competitors.

13. In the competition for the Athletic Pennant, points gained in all events will be included in the House point score.

14. Points will be awarded as follows:—

(4) 2, (5) 1.

Championship Events (1) 16, (2) 10, (3) 6, (4) 4,
(5) 2.
