RULES

2. None but officials and competitors are allowed on the course. **All competitors must leave the course immediately on the conclusion of their event.**

3. The Referee shall decide all questions relating to the conduct of the meeting not otherwise settled by these Rules.

4. (a) Protests to be dealt with by the Committee; (b) No protest will be entertained unless lodged with one of the Judges within fifteen minutes of the conclusion of the event.

5. The Committee reserves the right to alter any handicap

6. All competitors must appear in the correct running costume.

7. In a Hurdle Race, any competitor knocking down three or more hurdles shall be disqualified.

8. No competitor shall enter in corresponding events in more than one age panel.

9. Changes in relay teams may be made only by consent of the committee.

10. All competitors must have been in attendance at the school one month prior to the date of the meeting.

11. In the Pennant sections, competitors must be under the specified age on 1st September.

12. The Championships will be awarded on points gained in six of the championship events nominated previously by the competitors.

13. In the competition for the Athletic Pennant, points gained in all events will be included in the House Point Score.

14. Points will be awarded as follows:—
 Championship Events (1) 16, (2) 10, (3) 6, (4) 4,
 (5) 2.
 Championship Relays (1) 32, (2) 20, (3) 12, (4) 8.

15. The "Winn" Cup will be awarded for the Parade of Houses. Points, on the same scale as for the Championship Relays, will be awarded for this event and included in the Point Score.

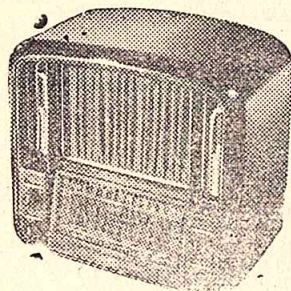

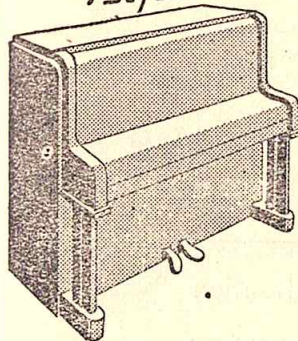
