## RULES

1. **Starting Post:** All Competitors must be at the Starting Post before second division is held.
2. **Starting Positions:** Competitors are to run in tracks as per programme.
3. **False Starts:** A competitor causing a false start shall be warned for the first breach; disqualified for second breach.
4. **Place-getters:** Placegetters shall receive from the Judges tokens denoting success gained, and must take these to the Recorders. 1st, Blue; 2nd, Red; 3rd, Yellow; 4th, White; 5th, Black.
5. **The Enclosure:** None but officials and competitors shall be allowed on the enclosure. At the conclusion of the event competitors must leave the enclosure.
6. **Protests and Referee:** The Referee shall be sole arbiter in points of law. Protests shall be dealt with by the Committee in consultation with the Referee. No Protest shall be considered unless lodged with the Referee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event.
7. **Sections:** The Meeting shall be conducted in three sections:
  - Senior: Under 20 years.
  - Junior: Comprising under 16 years panel and under 15 years panel.
  - Juvenile: Comprising under 14 years panel and under 13 years panel.
8. A Boy whose significant birthday falls on or before the 18th August is over the age for the panel. A competitor may compete in any age panel except where the event is for an age below the competitor's. No competitor may compete in more than one age panel for any one race.
9. **Point Scores:** Place winners of Divisions 1 and 2 shall be awarded the points:—
 

	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th
Division 1 .....	9	7	5	4	3
Division 2 .....	6	5	4	3	2

In relays the points for Division 1 shall be doubled.
10. **Circular Relay:** Teams of four, laps of 110 yards. A baton to be carried. Lines to be drawn 10 yards in front of and behind each starting point and contact between members of teams must be made between these lines. Failure to keep to tracks will entail disqualification.
11. **Broad Jump and Hop, Step and Jump:** Competitors shall have 3 jumps in rotation, at the conclusion of which the leading three may have one (1) more.
12. **Putting the Shot:** Senior, 12lb.; Junior, 8lb.; Juvenile, 6lb., shot to be used. The Put shall be made from a circle of 7ft. diameter. Other conditions as in Rule 11.
13. **Hurdles:** Senior, 120 yds., 3ft. high, 10 flights; approach 15 yards, finish 15 yards. Junior, 90 yds., 3ft., 8 flights, approach 14 yards, finish 13 yards. Juvenile, 60 yards, 2ft. 6ins. hurdles, 6 flights, approach 10 yards, finish 10 yards.
14. **High Jump:** Competitors shall have 3 attempts in rotation:—
  - Senior, compulsory height 4ft. 6ins., 3in. rises to 5ft.
  - Under 16, compulsory height 4ft. 4ins., 3in. rises to 4ft. 10ins.
  - Under 15, compulsory height 4ft. 2ins., 3in. rises to 4ft. 8ins.
  - Under 14, compulsory height 4ft 2ins., 2in. rises to 4ft 4ins.
  - Under 13, compulsory height 3ft. 9ins., 2in. rises to 4ft. 1in.
15. In the event of a tie in all field games events, the count-back is to be used.
16. In events run in circular lanes, each competitor must keep in his allotted lanes. A competitor who steps on or inside the line shall be disqualified.

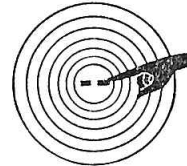

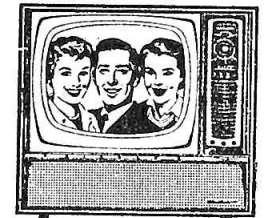
