# SWIMMING CARNIVAL RULES



1. Competitors must be properly attired in costume or trunks and distinguishing cap.

2. Competitors must report to the marshalls as soon as their events are called.

3. Should the entry for an event necessitate heats or semi-finals such will be arranged.

4. Method of starting: "Ready, Go". (By word of mouth).

5. If the toes leave the starting board before the word "Go" a whistle shall be blown by the Check Starter for a false start. Repetition of the offence will entail disqualification of the offender.

6. Any competitor who swims out of his lane during a race shall be disqualified.

7. Every competitor must touch the board on the completion of each lap, and at the finish of each race competitors are advised to touch with the hand ABOVE the water.

8. In breaststroke and butterfly events, when turning or finishing the touch must be made with two hands simultaneously above the water.

9. At the finish of each race, competitors will remain in their lane, until placed by the Judges. They must then leave the water immediately.

10. Place-getters shall report to the Result Stewards immediately after they leave the water.

11. Events will be in five divisions: Senior for boys and over 16 on March 17th, 1959; Under 16, for boys under 16 and over 15 on March 17th, 1959; Under 15, for boys under 15 and over 14, on March 17th, 1959; Under 13, for boys under 13, on March 17th, 1959.

12. Competitors for the Championship Pennants in the five divisions shall nominate a number of events: Senior, Under 16, and Under 15, five events; Under 14 and Under 13, four events. Points won in these nominated events only will be considered in allotting the Championship Pennants.

13. The champion in each division will be the competitor who gains the highest number of points in his division in the events nominated by him.

14. The Champion House will be the House that gains the highest aggregate points in all divisions.

15. Points will be allotted as follows: Age Championships—1st, 8; 2nd, 5; 3rd, 3; 4th, 2; 5th, 1. Relay—1st, 16; 2nd, 10; 3rd, 6; 4th, 4.

16. Diving from the three-metre board shall include—"Running Header", "Standing Header", and two fancy dives. Juvenile Section may use the one-metre board.

17. Failure to comply with these rules or to obey the orders of officials will result in disqualification.
