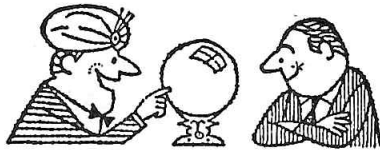

RULES



1. COSTUMES.

- (1) Singlets — to be House Colour.
- (2) Shorts — blue with red stripe (P.E. shorts). No athlete will compete unless he is dressed as above. *This rule shall be strictly enforced.*

2. MARSHALLING.

- (1) Shall take place in "Competitor's Stand" on the western side of the ground.
- (2) All competitors remain in the stand until called to the start.
- (3) No competitor is allowed on the ground unless moving to or from an event. Don't linger.
- (4) When called for an event the marshall in the stand will check you out to the marshall at the start. Move quickly to the start so as to assist in the running of the carnival.
- (5) Warm up area — behind the marshalling stand or outside the Oval.

NO WARMING UP ON THE OVAL.

3. RESULTS.

- (1) At the completion of each race, competitors must return to the finishing line in their respective lanes until places are allotted.
- (2) If you receive a baton, go immediately to the Recorder's Table and check in result in the order of finishing, i.e., 1, 2, 3, 4 and placings in that order. Then immediately leave the ground.
- (3) Place Token — Blue, 1st; Red, 2nd; Yellow, 3rd; Green, 4th; White, 5th.

4. START.

- (1) All competitors must move to the starting position when the announcement is made. Then await the marshall's directions.
- (2) Starter's orders will be:—
"On your marks . . ."
Get set . . .
"The Gun!"
- (3) A whistle blast signifies a false start.
- (4) Competitors will be disqualified for two (2) false starts.

5. PROTESTS

If any competitor has any grounds for protest whatsoever, he must protest to the referee (Mr. C. Goffett) within 15 minutes of the completion of the event.

6. ENCLOSURE.

Only officials and competitors who are moving to or from an event, or who actually competing, are allowed on the oval.

7. HIGH JUMP.

Competitors shall have three attempts in rotation, i.e. there may be 3 rounds at each height. Three successive failures shall exclude a competitor.

Senior: Compulsory height 4' 6" — 3" rises to 5'.
16 years — Compulsory height 4' 4" — 3" rises to 4' 10".
15 years — Compulsory height 4' 3" — 3" rises to 4' 9".
14 years — Compulsory height 4' 2" — 2" rises to 4' 4".
13 years — Compulsory height 3' 11" — 2" rises to 4' 1".
12 years — Compulsory height 3' 8" — 2" rises to 4'.

In the event of a tie, the best record on a count-back, as used in A.A.F. rules, shall decide the place winners.

8. HURDLES.

Senior — 120 yds.: 3ft. high: 10 flights: approach 15 yds., finish 15 yds.
Junior (15 and 16 yrs.) — 90 yds.: 3' high: 8 flights: approach 14 yds.,
finish 13 yds.

Juvenile (12, 13, 14 yrs.) — 60 yds.: 2' 6" high: 6 flights: approach 10 yds.,
finish 10 yds.

9. AGE DIVISIONS.

(1) The meeting shall be conducted in six sections: Senior, 16 years, 15 years, 14 years, 13 years and 12 years. An athlete whose birthday falls before the 1st January, 1961, is over age for that division.

(2) No competitor shall enter in corresponding events in more than one age panel.

(3) A false entry disqualifies the competitor for all events and in the event of a relay race, the whole team is disqualified.

10. PUTTING THE SHOT.

Weights to use used:

Senior — 12lbs.

Under 16 and under 15 years — 8lbs.

Under 14 and under 13 years — 6lbs.

11. CIRCULAR RELAYS.

(1) Teams of four: laps of 110 yds: a baton to be carried: lines to be drawn 11 yards in front of and behind each starting point, and the transfer of each baton must be made between these lines. Failure to keep to allotted tracks means disqualification.

(2) A baton accidentally dropped may be recovered, but only by the competitor who dropped it.

12. POINT SCORE.

Place winners shall be awarded points as follows:—

1) Novice and Championship events: 1st, 16; 2nd, 10; 3rd, 6; 4th, 4; 5th, 2.

(2) House March: 1st, 32; 2nd, 20; 3rd, 12; 4th, 8.

(3) Relays: 1st, 32; 2nd, 20; 3rd, 12; 4th, 8.

(4) Tug O' War: 1st, 32; 2nd, 20; 3rd, 12; 4th, 8.

TROPHIES.

The winning House will receive the "Arthur Shield" to be held for twelve months. The "Win Cup" will be awarded for the March Past. Pennants shall be awarded for Age Divisions.
